

Blackbird Bend Casino near Onawa, Iowa is monitoring the increasing water levels in the nearby Missouri River, but does not anticipate any adverse impact on its operations in the days ahead. According to current Army Corps of Engineers and National Weather Service projections, river levels at Decatur, Nebraska are not expected to reach a stage that would allow water to impact the casino property.

“The casino and our Events Center remain open, and all roads in the vicinity of our gaming property are not being affected,” said Brad Appleton, Chief Operating Officer for the Blackbird Bend Corporation. “The casino is fully operational at this time, and we don’t expect that to change. However, in the best possible interest of the safety and well being of our guests and team members, we will of course continue to closely monitor river levels and projections from government sources.”
